- Fill out and submit the attached 2010 - 2011 Scholarship Re-application Form. Use additional sheets of paper as needed.
- Submit an official copy of your spring 2010 class schedule; if the class schedule does not include the number units each course is worth, include an official enrollment verification of your full-time status.
- Submit an official transcript of all your undergraduate and graduate grades recorded to date, including your fall 2009 grades. **Note: Schools issuing transcripts with pass/fail or credit/no credit grades are not acceptable. You must submit complete grades or written evaluations from your class instructor.**
- Submit an original two-page essay describing your college and career goals.
- In addition to the two-page essay, answer 3 of the 9 questions on a separate sheet of paper. One paragraph for each of the 3 questions you choose is adequate.
 1. What challenges have you encountered?
 2. Explain the importance of your field of study in today's society.
 3. Describe how you have demonstrated leadership ability both in and out of school.
 4. Discuss a special attribute or accomplishment that sets you apart.
 5. Describe your most meaningful achievements and how they relate to your field of study and your future goals.
 6. Pick an experience from your own life and explain how it has influenced your development.
 7. How has your education contributed to who you are today?
 8. Choose a person or persons you admire and explain why.
 9. Choose a book or books that have affected you deeply and explain why.
